From the above figures, we can deduce that:
(i) the vast majority of pupils in all Class levels are at a STEN of 5 or higher
(ii) in $2^{\text {nd }}$ Class $60 \%$ of the class are in the Above Average to Well Above Average range
(iii) in $3^{\text {rd }}$ Class $50 \%$ of the class are in the same range
(iv) in $4^{\text {th }}$ Class $46 \%$ of the class are in the same range
(v) in $5^{\text {th }}$ Class $36 \%$ of the class are in the same range
(vi) in $6^{\text {th }}$ Class $27 \%$ of the class are in the same range
(vii) Based on the above, on average $44 \%$ of each class is in the Above Average to Well Above Average Range
(viii) $6^{\text {th }}$ Class are the only class to have more than a tenth in the Below Average to Well Below Average range (27\%)
(ix) At every class level, the largest STEN grouping falls within the Average range
